1. Subcommittee Updates:

a. Education and Outreach

b. Emergency Shelter Network

- i. Chrissy reported there have been **87** participants who have gone through the Elder Shelter Program.
- ii. We received a copy of the MOU used by Sarah Duval from the Buffalo, New York Center for Elder Law and Justice the Buffalo NY Elder Shelter Program. The Subcommittee will draft a MOU that fits our program.
- iii. Chrissy reported on the Subcommittee meeting held on 03/12/2019.

c. Volunteer Guardianship Program: Susan reported eight volunteers completed the program. We want to see how things go for this first group before we schedule another training in the fall of 2019.

d. By-Laws: The coalition has operated without by-laws for the past 13 years and it time to codify our structure and process. Dayton emailed draft by-laws to the members. No one provide input by the March 8th deadline.

e. World Elder Abuse Awareness Day: The event takes place on June 15th each year, which is a Saturday this year. We need to form a subcommittee ASAP. Julie volunteered to help with the event but we still need a chair and more volunteers. Please respond by **March 22nd** if you are interested.
