PPACG Area Agency on Aging Social Security 101 Classes

The Pikes Peak Area Council of Governments Area Agency on Aging (PPAAA) and the Social Security Administration are partnering for the fourth year to present Social Security 101, "Understanding Your Social Security Benefits". 2020 Social Security 101 presentations are from 4:00-5:30 PM. June 1, July 1 and September 28 are webinars and require RSVP at www.ppacg.org/events. Classes on August 24 and November 9 are in-person at PPACG with RSVP at either ppacg.org/events or (719) 471-2096.

The educational presentation is for people approaching retirement age, adult children and interested people. This session will cover many of the common retirement questions including:

- * Eligibility for retirement
- * How age affects retirement benefit
- * How work affects retirement benefit
- * How non-covered pensions (PERA, FEP) can potentially affect your Retirement and Survivor benefits.

Also discussed are spousal, children's, survivor, and disability benefits with the qualifications and application process for each. Those attending this program are encouraged to set up a "my Social Security" account online at www.socialsecurity.gov/myaccount.
