CHANNELS FOR CHANGE: Strategies for Individualized services- parent education and family development. **GOAL - Increase Parental Awareness of the impacts of trauma.**

Objective: By 2025, 35% of El Paso County parents of children ages 0-6 years old will have been educated on the impact of childhood trauma.

CHANNELS FOR CHANGE: Organizational and Practice Change – Evidence Based Practice. **Goal - increase awareness and utilization of strategies to strengthen families and prevent- child abuse and neglect in El Paso County.**

OBJECTIVE: By August of 2020 provide evidence based education to 35 community organization/ businesses to increase awareness of the effects of childhood trauma and strategies to address trauma and strengthen families, with 25% of those reporting implementation of strategies.



Channel for Change: Agency Collaboration and community Capacity Building. **GOAL- Create Neighborhood Cohesion**

OBJECTIVE: By December 2020, create increased community cohesion in Hillside neighborhood/ or in alignment with neighborhood projects in progress.

Channels for change: Strategies for policy reforms –Policy agenda setting.

Goal – Building Capacity for families to care for their children by increasing family friendly policies.

Objective: By 2020, create a family-friendly business rating system in El Paso County.

RFP – For Local Planning Grant

- Release – 7/23/2018
- Due – 8/23/2018 awards 10
- Projects between \$35,000 - \$50,000
- One application for county
- Must have partners, align with developed framework

Submitting on organizational and practice change – expanding education of providers. Lutheran Family Services will be the lead agency.

What we are working on

- **Channel for Change: Organizational and Practice Change –Evidence Based Practice**
- **Goal: Increase awareness and utilization of strategies to strengthen families and prevent child abuse and neglect in El Paso County.**
- **Objective:** By September of 2019, provide evidence based education **to 15 organizations/business** working with improvised – high risk families to increase awareness of the effects of childhood trauma and strategies to address trauma and strengthen protective factor families, with 20% reporting implementation of strategies.
